Earning a Master of Arts Degree in Industrial-Organizational Psychology

An M.A. in Industrial Organization Psychology can be awarded following the successful completion of required coursework and internships. At the beginning of the semester in which a student expects to be eligible for the master's degree, he or she is required to submit online a Petition for Program Completion to the Office of Academic Records. The petition is a request to conduct an audit to determine eligibility for the degree. Students who meet the requirements are eligible to participate in the next scheduled commencement. All students who file a Petition for Program Completion will be charged a fee.
