TCSPP M.A. Psychology Articulation Agreement with Universidad Peruana de Ciencias Aplicadas (UPC)

Transfer Student Responsibilities

- A. To qualify for the Transfer Admissions Guarantee, active UPC students must submit an application for admission to The Chicago School, and shall be subject to the M.A. Psychology admission requirements.

The partnership between The Chicago School of Professional Psychology and the Universidad Peruana de Ciencias Aplicadas (UPC) allows graduating UPC students to transfer up to one year of credit into The Chicago School of Professional Psychology's online Master of Arts in Psychology (MAP) degree.

Through this partnership, up to 18 hours (6 courses) of transfer credit from UPC may be applied towards the following courses in the MAP program offered at The Chicago School of Professional Psychology:
