

Articulation Agreement

- I. Articulation Agreement between
 - a. Certificate in Instructional Design (Cert. ID) to EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT).
- II. Statement of Purpose
 - a. This agreement has been entered into by Cert. ID and EdD EPT. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit articulation and provide a smooth transition from a certificate program into its related degree program. It is further recognized that the attached appendix or appendices shall describe the approved courses and the admissions eligibility. This agreement identifies all required and equivalent courses.
- III. Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer and/or degree:
 - a. The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits and/or degree credits shall be in full compliance with institutional policies and all other state and Federal education policies pertaining to credit transfer. Program specific requirements and/or required courses/degree are listed and defined in Appendix A of this agreement. Students will be subject to the required admissions requirements of the EdD EPT.
 - b. Interested students will need to apply to the EdD EPT program. Students successfully completing the Cert. ID with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher are guaranteed acceptance into the EdD EPT Program.
- IV. Length of the Agreement
 - a. This agreement shall be in force upon the date it is signed.
 - b. This agreement shall be valid until (May 31, 2022). The Agreement will be reevaluated for renewal six months prior to expiration.
 - c. Either party may terminate this agreement but will need to work with institutional timelines for change (catalog publication).
- V. Details of publication of Agreement
 - This information will need to reside in the Academic Catalog. Publication is required to include the process for articulation to a degree program, the specific courses, and the admission eligibility requirements.
 - b. Routine program modifications affecting will apply to this agreement as they are approved and implemented.
- VI. Required Signatures
 - a. Campus or Curriculum Academic Dean(s)
 - b. Chief Academic Officer
