



Internal Articulation Agreement

Articulation Agreement between MA Applied Psychology and EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT)

I. Statement of Purpose

- a. This agreement between the MA Applied Psychology (MAP) and EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT) programs is intended to facilitate credit articulation and provide a smooth transition from one related degree program (MA) to another (EdD).
- b. This agreement allows qualifying The Chicago School MAP students to apply to the EdD EPT program and be considered for acceptance if all admissions requirements are met.
- c. Students will be allowed to take courses outlined in Appendix A in lieu of MAP Concentration Courses and have them count toward degree completion of the MAP program, thus reducing time to completion of the EdD EPT degree. It is further recognized that Appendix A shall describe the approved courses and this agreement shall describe the admissions eligibility. This agreement identifies all required and equivalent courses.

II. Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer and/or Degree

- a. The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits and/or degree credits shall be in full compliance with institutional policies and all other state and Federal education policies pertaining to credit transfer. Program specific requirements and/or required courses/degree are listed and defined in Appendix A of this agreement. Students will be subject to the required admissions requirements of EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT). Students taking advantage of any benefits provided under this agreement remain subject to all other institutional policies and requirements not otherwise specifically addressed in this agreement.
- b. Students must apply to the EdD EPT program under the terms of this agreement and be accepted in order for this agreement.

III. Length of the Agreement

- a. This agreement shall be valid until August 31, 2026. Thereafter, the agreement will be reevaluated for renewal.



- b. Either degree program may terminate this agreement at any time, following institutional procedures.

IV. Details of Publication of Agreement

- a. The details of this agreement will reside in the institution's Academic Catalog and will include the process for articulation to another degree program, the specific courses, and the admission eligibility requirements.
- b. Program modifications affecting either program involved in this agreement may require re-evaluation and/or amendment of Appendix A subsequent to implementation.

V. Early Acceptance into EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT)

- a. Student must have an overall GPA from the MA Applied Psychology that is 3.0 or higher.
- b. Student must be making satisfactory progress in the ARP coursework.
- c. In addition to the above requirement, student must also:
 - i. Student must submit the following general application materials:
 - i. Online application
 - ii. Personal Statement/Admissions essay
 - iii. Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
 - iv. Official transcripts
 - ii. Meet professional comportment guidelines set forth in the Student Handbook and have no pending referrals to the Student Affairs Committee.
 - iii. Student must meet all other admission requirements in The Chicago School Student Handbook and Academic Catalog for this program.

VI. Enrollment in EdD EPT Level Courses

- a. Student must be accepted into EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT) under the terms of this agreement before enrolling in EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT) courses.
- b. Enrollment must coincide with the EdD EPT program's "start" schedule.
- c. Conferral of MA Applied Psychology will require a total of 30 credit hours.
- d. Up to 9 credit hours may be applied from EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT) per Appendix A. Student must apply for



degree conferral once the graduation requirements are met. The standard degree conferral fee will apply.

- e. EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT) courses taken while a student in MA Applied Psychology will count toward the graduation requirements of both programs.

VII. Tuition

- a. Students enrolled in EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT) courses under this agreement will pay the MA Applied Psychology tuition rate for EdD Educational Psychology and Technology (EdD EPT) courses while enrolled in MA Applied Psychology.

- a. The following Program Articulation Table contains all academic details of courses and/or degree that are qualified for credit transfer under this agreement.
