



Internal Articulation Agreement

Articulation Agreement between Child & Adolescent Psychology Certificate and MA Counseling Psychology

I. Statement of Purpose

- a. This agreement has been entered into by the Certificate in Child and Adolescent Psychology program and MA Counseling Psychology program. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate course association from the Child and Adolescent Certificate program to the MA Counseling Psychology program.
- b. Students will be allowed to associate a maximum of 3 courses (9 credits) into MA Counseling Psychology upon completion of the Certificate in Child and Adolescent Psychology program. This agreement identifies all required and equivalent courses.

II. Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer and/or Degree

- a. The evaluation and transfer/association of earned college credits and/or degree credits shall be in full compliance with The Chicago School institutional policies and all other state and federal education policies pertaining to credit transfer. Program specific requirements and/or required courses/degree are listed and defined below in this agreement.
- b. The Child and Adolescent Certificate courses taken by a student enrolled in the MA Counseling Psychology program may count toward the graduation requirements of both programs (Certificate and MA) provided the grade received for the Child and Adolescent Certificate course is a B or higher (as required by The Chicago School Academic Grade Policy for graduate degrees). For courses with a grade lower than B, the student will be required to retake the course for the MA Counseling Psychology credit once enrolled in the MA Counseling Psychology program.

III. Length of the Agreement

- a. This agreement shall be valid until August 31, 2026. Thereafter, the agreement will be reevaluated for renewal.
- b. Either degree program may terminate this agreement at any time, following institutional procedures.



IV. Details of Publication of Agreement

- a. The details of this agreement will reside in the institution's Academic Catalog and will include the process for articulation to another degree program, the specific courses, and the admission eligibility requirements.
- b. Program modifications affecting either program involved in this agreement may require re-evaluation and/or amendment of Appendix A subsequent to implementation.

V. Appendix A

- a. The following Program Articulation Table contains all academic details of courses and/or degree that are qualified for credit transfer under this agreement.
